## Degrees of Kinship and Affinity Under Italian Law

The Italian Civil Code (Articles 74 ff) contain the criteria for determining the degree of kinship and affinity of your relatives. This degree is a fundamental concept in Italian law and is an essential part of, amongst other things, the rules of inheritance and succession.

Kinship is the legal relationship between persons descending from the same root and who are therefore bound by consanguinity.

Straight line relatives are people in a descending/ascending line while lateral relatives such as brothers, sisters and cousins who whilst having a common root (e.g. father or grandfather), do not descend from each other.

In the straight line, the degree of kinship is calculated by counting the persons up to the common root.

In the lateral line the degree of kinship/affinity is computed in terms of generations, going up from one of the relatives to the common root (who is not counted) and then descending from that root to the other relative.
